For each level, the work submitted demonstrates:

90–100 / A+

Rare and exceptional work

Advanced knowledge of concepts and techniques, exceptional skill, and a unique, original viewpoint on the subject matter which exceed the requirements and learning outcomes of a project or course

85–89 / A

80–84 / A-

Excellent work

Thorough knowledge of concepts and techniques and a high degree of skill and/or some elements of originality; all requirements and learning outcomes are met

75–79 / B+

Very good work

A high level of comprehension of concepts and techniques together with a fairly high degree of skill and/or some elements of originality

70–74 / B

Good work

A good level knowledge of concepts and techniques together with considerable skill

65–69 / C+

Competent work

An acceptable level of knowledge of concepts and techniques together with considerable skill representing the student's competence to continue in the program

60–64 / C

Fairly competent work

An acceptable level of knowledge of concepts and techniques together with some skill

55–59 / D+

Passing work

More than minimal knowledge of required concepts and techniques together with limited skill

50–54 / D

Poor work

A lack of effort and/or minimal knowledge of concepts and techniques despite completion of all project or course requirements

31–49 / F

Very poor work

Insufficient effort and/or minimal comprehension of concepts and techniques; learning outcomes are not met despite the completion of all components

0–31 / F

Inadequate work

Partial effort and/or minimal or no comprehension of concepts and techniques; requirements are not complete or there is no work submitted for evaluation
